
Welcome at General Children's Hospital "Panagiotis & Aglaia Kyriakou"





The hospital was instituted in 1933, after Aglaia Kyriakou donated 15.000.000 drachmas









Important milestones of the hospital

- 15 August 1938 in full action including 20 beds
- 1946 → 140 beds with tremendous offer in scientific, humanistic and social task
- The Council Board of the hospital established new goals for the upgrade and the improvement of new wards as well as the construction of modern laboratories





The Hospital...


• It is the biggest pediatric hospital of Greece and one of the biggest in Europe. It includes 700 beds and can host children and adolescents from 0 to 16 years of age. The age limits can be exceeded in special occasions.


• There are wards for all the pediatric specialties (internal medicine & surgical wards). There are also 110 beds of ICUs for children, adolescents and newborns, as well as special and unique clinics.

The History...

- Constructed in 1896 and started to work as a hospital in 1901
- In 1929 it was renamed as Patriot Foundation
- In 1939 it was incorporated under the foundation name «Children's clinic Panagiotis & Aglaia Kyriakou»
- In 1940 (WWII) it became a military hospital
- In 1943 it was commanded by the German army
- In 1944 it started to work again as a free Greek hospital with the name "Agia Sofia"
- In 1958 the "Agia Sofia" School for nurses was instituted
- In 1962 the main building was constructed
- Since 1983 it belongs to the National Health System of Greece
