In the <u>UK</u> we have a Child Branch and Childrens Nursing qualification - in the main hospitals employ childrens nurses but there are <u>cases of adult nurses</u> (general nurses) caring for children and working on childrens wards. Its not breaking the actual UK law if general nurses care for children but rather good practice <u>recommended</u> from our NMC & RCN that CYP are cared for by dedicated trained children's nurses





Yes, In <u>Portugal</u> it is allowed to work in the paediatric ward, although the Professional Specialty College of Infant health and paediatrics nursing has <u>issued an opinion</u> on the paediatric ratios and specialties in these wards. In this way, the Ordem dos Enfermeiros has established that, <u>at least, 2/3</u> of the nurses that are integrated in the paediatric services' team must have the Paediatric Nursing Speciality.





By law a registered nurse can work on any ward they have had a **general pediatric training** during their training becoming a general nurse (bachelor).

In **the Netherlands** though a general nurse only works on a pediatric ward for a few weeks in preparation of becoming a pediatric nurse, so just before entering the post graduate nursing course in Pediatrics.

Estonia is small country and we have only two children's hospitals. In Estonia in the paediatric wards can work nurses who have been finished 3,5 y studies in general nursing. Nurses have the opportunity to go through work-related paediatric training programs at work. Also they have possible to study in master studies (health science studies) and after that work as special nurse or advance nurse in children's hospital or health centres.





Also, negotiations are ongoing with the <u>Croatian</u> Chamber of Nurses and the Ministry of Health about creating a specialization program for pediatric nurses.
