Dear President,

During the 34° PNAE meeting (17th-18th October 2019,in Zara, Croatia), Dr Immacolata Dall'Oglio, PNAE member on behalf of National Federation of Nursing Professions Orders (FNOPI), told us about the confirmation of availability by FNOPI to host the new PNAE website. As PNAE new Chair/Co-ordinator, I am very happy to thank FNOPI for this great opportunity for PNAE. - 6- We shared the website proposal with PNAE members




The evolution of PNAE format
