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35° PNAE meeting (on-line)



- New priority setting exercise (2020-2022)
- Work alone or work in twos/groups on 3 or 4 issues
- Dissemination of outputs (including webinars?)
- Congress (Estonia) was June 2020 now 2021 due to Covid19
- New challenges / new changes in society/ new clinical advances / new changing priorities

- Update prior statements, relevance, changes & literature and dates and ?send out new questionnaires (2) and creating uniformed European guidelines and procedures for Paediatric nurses (1)
- Agree about previous work activities what to do with them (leave or develop) (4)
- Make a statement on family-centred care for children (using European Foundation for the care of Newborn infants - EFCNI etc) (1)
- All admitted children / adolescents must have the opportunity to have a parent with them (1)
- Creating online support for children and parent (1)
- Support professional content and policy regarding pediatric nursing (1)

- Develop an updated statement on 'children' and 'pediatric' definition (1)
- Discussion about the age limit of pediatric and pediatric nursing, especially for young adult affected by chronically illness (18 years old or 24??) We could provide a literature review, a survey and finally a statement (2)
- Creating a unique 'textbook' on Pediatric nursing at the European level (1)

- More research/scientific approaches to activities (2)
- Be active collaborating in research across Europe about pediatric nursing .....(Such as - we could 1collaborate with Espnic and/or 2- develop a Delphi study about research priority about pediatric nursing across Europe) (2)
- Influence to the development of nursing through international research projects range of nursing care (1)
- Support a collaboration across 1 or 2 countries or more to support a Phd/Research project etc (PNAE would not finance this but we could support) (1)
- Nursing exchange for education and gaining experience (1)

 Four of PNAE said COVID-19 but 3 others said no to this directly as other associations are doing this but 2 said we could integrate into other work activities /standards /safeguarding /workforce etc

- Recruitment and workforce Issues (7) plus safe staffing (1)
- Website and communication (2)
- Care of children in Primary Care School Nurses/Community Nurses (1)
- Prevention of involuntary detention of children by painful procedures (1)
- Neonates (4) Education, skills and Care policy updates (Contact Ivona)
- Mental Health Assessment and support or work with another Association etc to write a statement (1)
