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European PEWS survey

European PEWS survey: aims

- To collect information about the systems and practices hospitals have in place to recognise and respond to clinical deterioration
- Qs about the existence of policies about taking obs and use of track and trigger systems
- Systems for responding to deterioration, such as MET or RRT
- Organizational systems to support the recognition and response to deterioration (education, audits)

Team

- Lead: Sue Chapman, GOSH, UK, Deputy Chair of ESPNIC Resuscitation Section
- PEWS experts: Gerri Sefton, Catherine Sheridan, Lyvonne Tume
- Country Leads will be identified (proposals from Spain, Ireland, Greece, Poland and Germany)

The survey and where are we at

- A modified version of the «Survey of recognition and response systems in Australia» developed by the Australian Commission on Safety and Quality in Healthcare (2011) was developed (A modified Italian version was already used in 2018 for another project)
- A total of 50 questions on survey monkey
- Need for further content validation from a group of 10 experts and face validation
- The survey will be translated by country leads
- Timeline: need to discuss with the project lead (Sent to ESPNIC members and PNAE country leads by november/december 2020)
