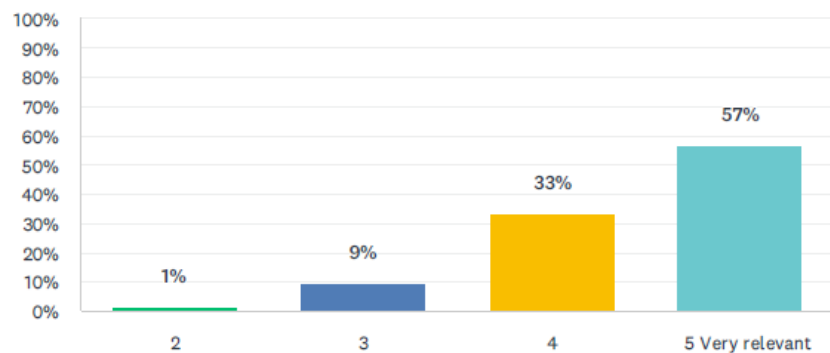

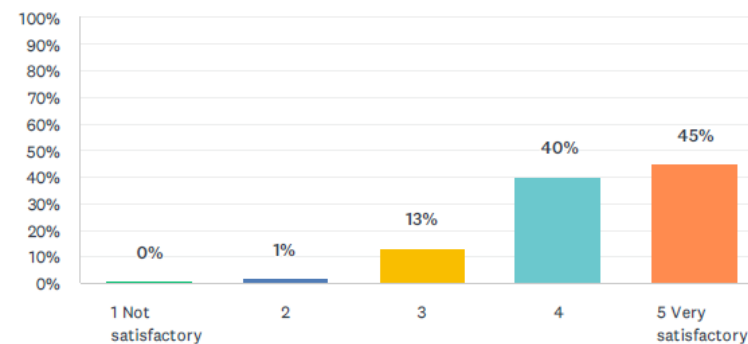
How do you evaluate the relevance of the topics proposed for 6th PNAE Congress ?

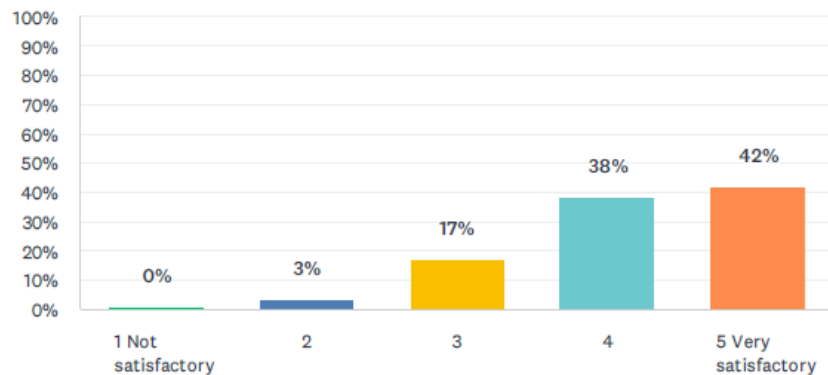

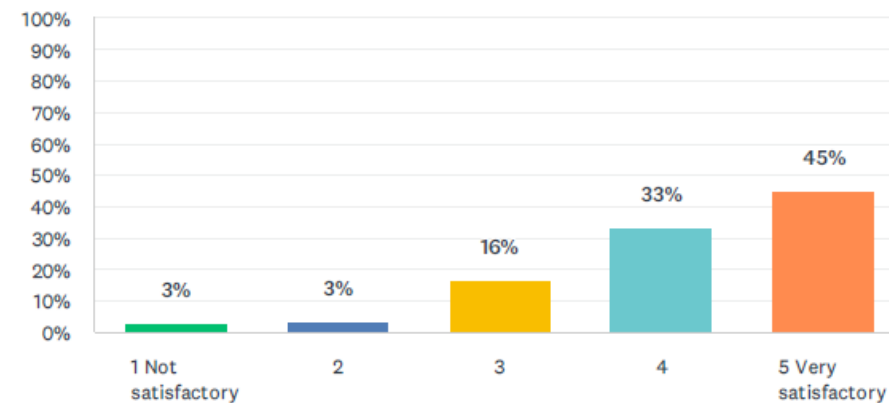
D3 3) How do you rate the quality of the Oral Presentations ?

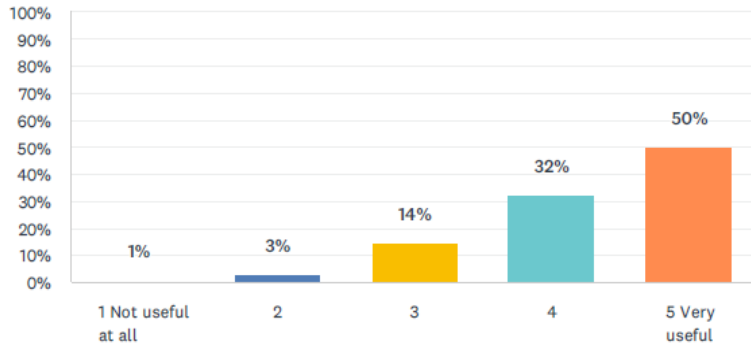

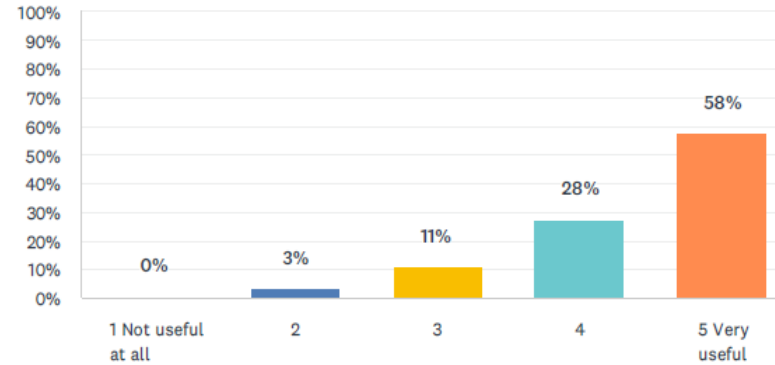
How do you rate the usefulness of the 6th PNAE Congress for your professional development?

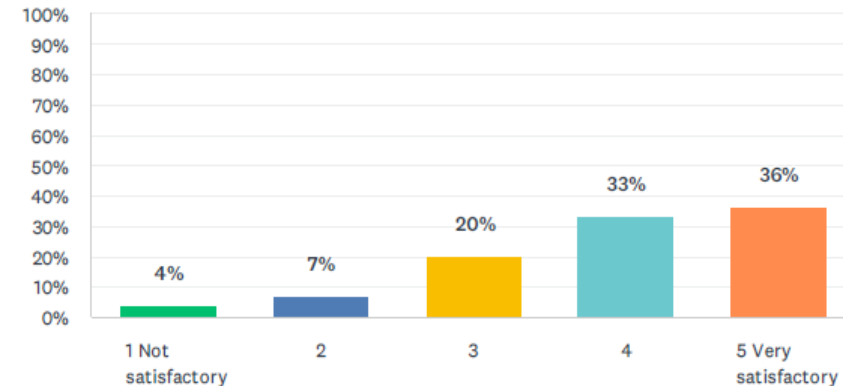
D6 6) How do you rate the usefulness of the 6th PNAE Congress for making national/international connections at a professional level ?
