Update about collaboration for EAPS Congress 2025

- **First contact through Jane Coad on last October ate about collaboration for EAPS Congress 2025**
- **PNAE Extra meeting in January 2025**

The group agreed

- That this new partnership should be viewed as an opportunity rather than a threat to PNAE own congress.
- That it would be beneficial for the PNAE to participate in the EAPS scientific committee, with one general member from PNAE and one PNAE member from the hosted country of the conference. However, there was a concern about the lack of PNAE delegates in some countries, which would need to be taken into account.
- To send out a survey to all members to gauge interest and availability for this EAPS scientific committee. The team also discussed the criteria for selecting a representative, with a focus on good communication skills and the ability to work with other nurses and doctors
- That JC with Immacolata shall email Pierre with these principles and our answer.

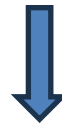

Update about collaboration for EAPS Congress 2025

Also important:

- KdW emphasized the importance of maintaining a strong connection between the PNAE Congress and the EAPS Congress, suggesting that the PNAE delegates in the scientific EAPS committee should be in contact with the French organizers of our own PNAE congress 2026. IDO agreed, stressing the need for PNAE delegates to represent the organization and not just participate as individuals.
