What does mean to be an **ACTIVE MEMBER** of PNAE?

Active member and considerations:

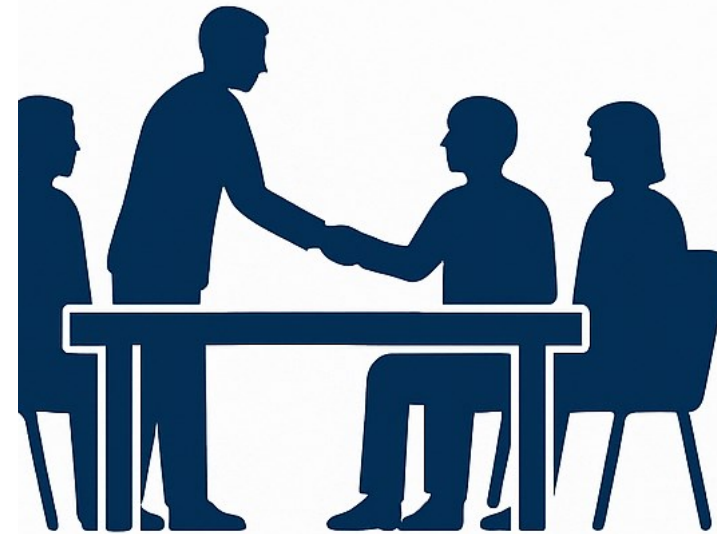
- The importance to be an active member is the presence and active collaboration

Attributes

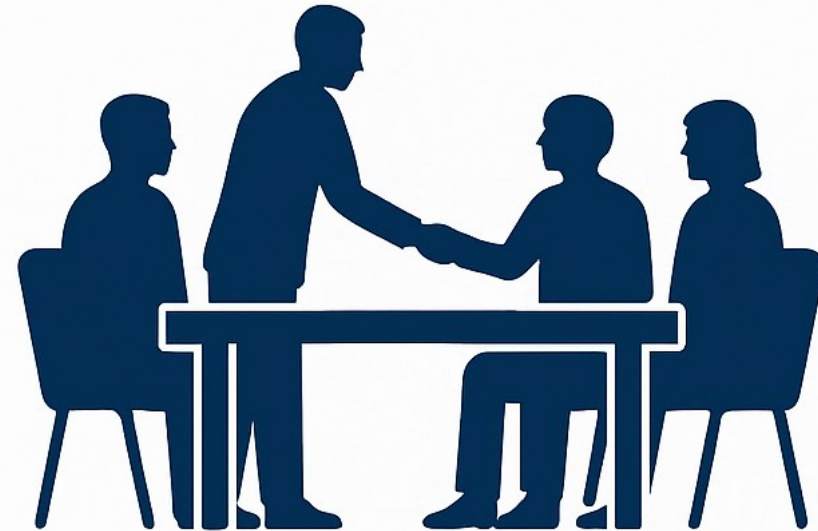
The Advisory Board consists of two volunteers who provide expert advice to the PNAE Co-ordination Team on an ‘as required’ basis.

Members are selected by the Co-ordination Team from experienced PNAE members, familiar with its operating procedures.

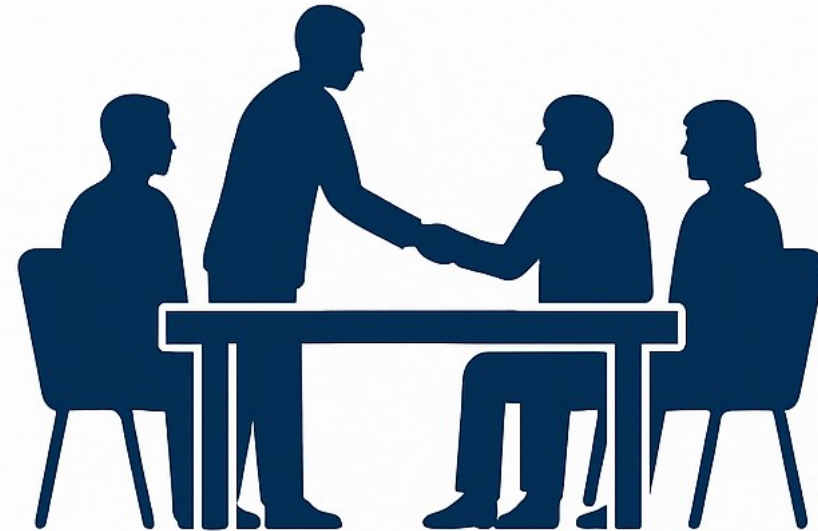

Attributes

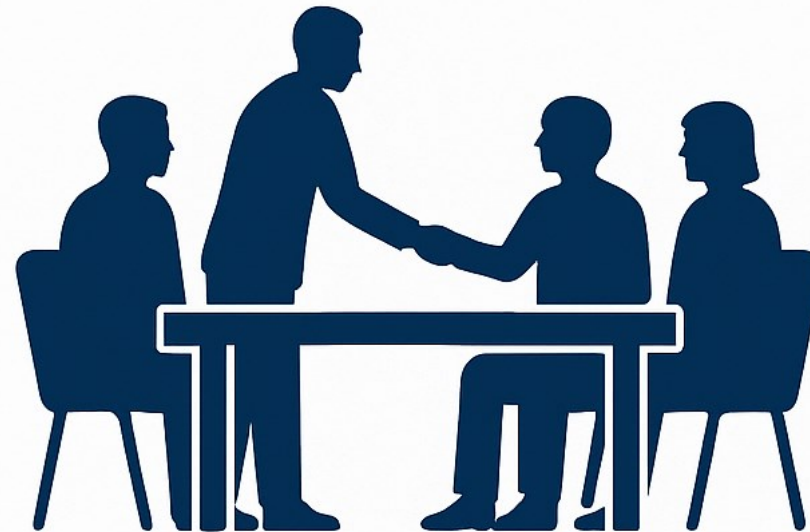
One member of the Advisory Board may be external to PNAE, such as a senior paediatric nurse with substantial clinical, academic, or international organisational experience.





Advisory Board Appointment Process

- The Advisory Board members are appointed by the PNAE Co-ordination Team following the official nomination and start of duties of each new Co-ordinator.
- Upon the appointment of a new Co-ordinator, the current Advisory Board members step down from their roles.
